

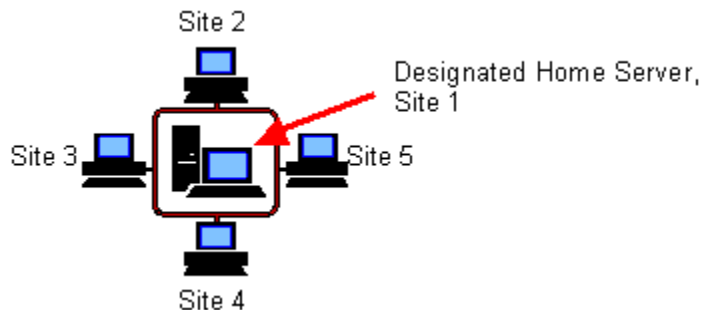

DINA (Distributed Intelligence Network Architecture) Manager

DINA MANAGER (Multisystem Configuration Tool)

The DINA Multisystem Manager is an interface designed to help a customer configure and synchronize the extensions, routing and e-mail of several distributed AltiWare systems. This multisite configuration tool allows administrators to synchronize the extensions in all systems so that all calls to an extension will be presented to the appropriate AltiWare system. The DINA Manager will synchronize multiple systems so changes to any system extension is reflected and updated in all systems. The DINA Manager synchronization of the extensions ensures that all voice mails to an extension will also be delivered appropriately. The tool can be used on any server, local or remote to an AltiWare system that has a connection with access to all the servers to be managed. The tool will synchronize extensions and workgroup pilot numbers. It can complete the functions below for multiple systems from a single location and session:

- Create virtual extensions and pilot workgroups with the correct forwarding parameters for multiple servers for specific extensions to be managed.
- Synchronize the extensions and pilot workgroups with same number in all systems so that all calls to an extension entering anywhere in the networked systems will be presented to the appropriate AltiWare system.
- Synchronize the extensions and pilot workgroups with same number in all systems so that all voice mails to an extension will be presented to the appropriate AltiWare system.



The DINA MANAGER is an application developed for providing tie trunk features to expand the AltiWare system. The application allows you to configure multiple systems synchronously, where previously, each AltiWare system had to be configured separately. This multisite configuration tool allows administrators to quickly structure and simultaneously configure several AltiWare systems from a single system, or "home server."
